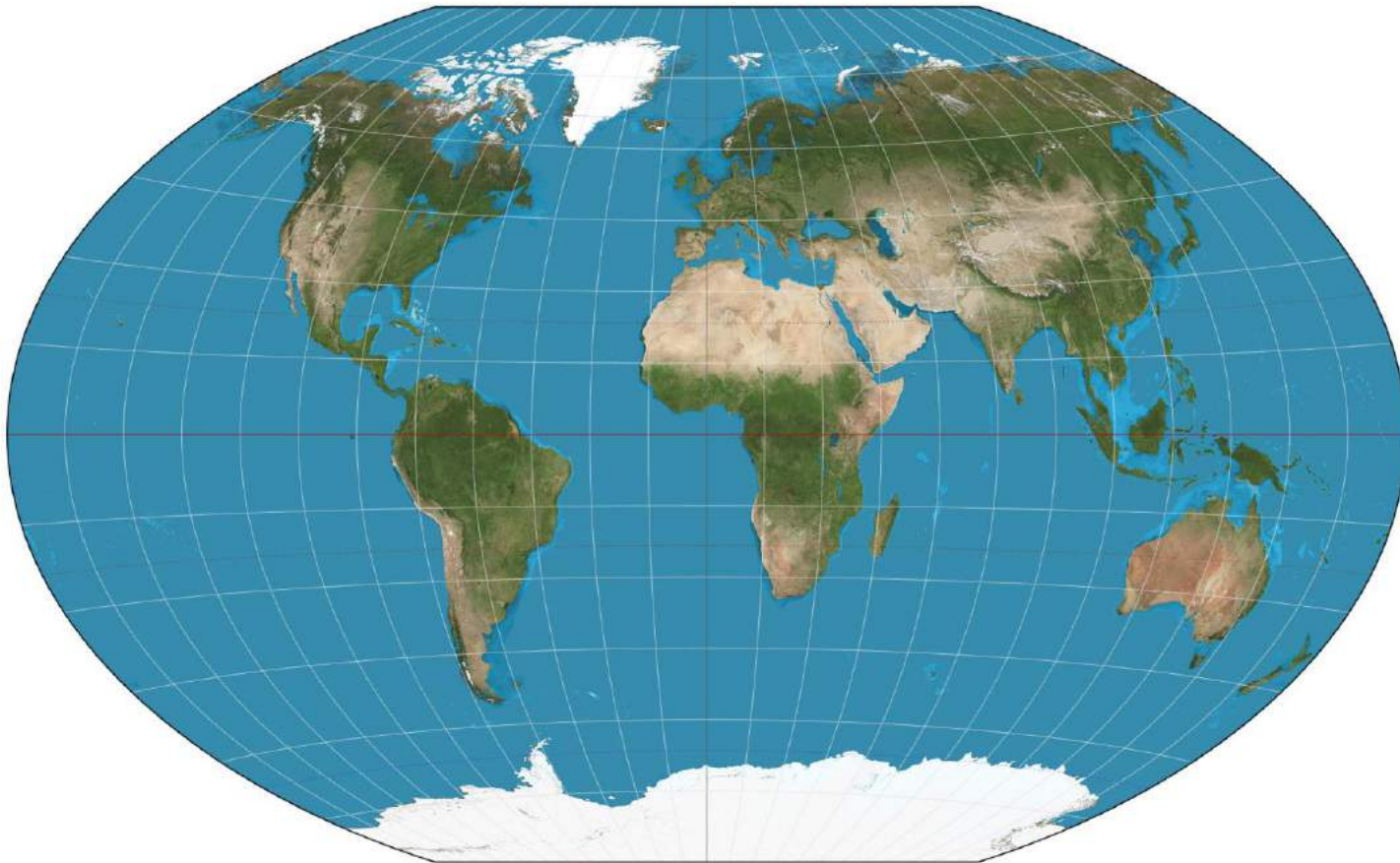

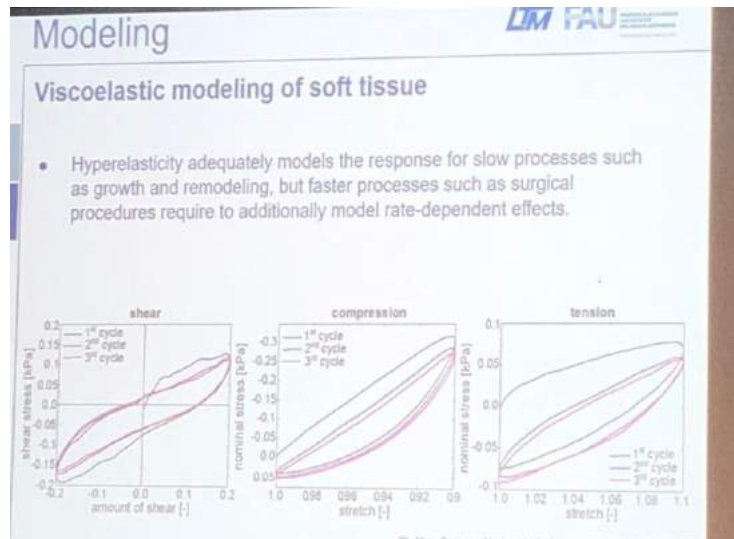


- is for Quarteroni, Alfio an invited speaker who gave the opening talk on day 2 looking at Numerical models of the cardiocirculatory system
